

**REPEAL RECREATION SUPPORT
SERVICE LEVY TO THE
RATHWELL MEMORIAL HALL**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given, in accordance with Section 318 (1) of The Municipal Act, that the Council of the Municipality of Norfolk Treherne intends to hold a Public Hearing at **9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 11th, 2021**, in the Council Chambers, regarding the Repeal of the Rural Municipality of South Norfolk By-Law 2439/2002.

Council is proposing to repeal By-Law 2439/2002 which authorizes an annual special services tax on each parcel of land benefiting from the service. The annual amount taxed is equivalent to the amount of funding provided to the Rathwell Memorial Hall.

The funding will continue to be provided, however, Council is proposing that the costs for these services, starting in 2021, will be covered under the general levy on the whole municipality on an "at large" basis.

Council will hear any person who wishes to make a representation, ask questions, or register an objection to the By-Law to repeal By-Law 2439/2002. Objections must be received in writing and contain your name, address, property description and grounds for the objection. Notices of objection must be received prior to the adjournment of the hearing.

The public is invited to attend the virtual hearing via Zoom or via conference call. Connection details will be provided prior to the hearing. Please register your interest to participate with the Chief Administrative Officer (see contact information below).
